Eastern Redbud (*Cercis canadensis*)
 grows to 20-30 ft. height. Beautiful pink "red buds" in Spring. Grows in moist, well-drained soil in full sun to partial shade.

Pin Oak (*Quercus palustris*) reaches a mature size of 50-70 feet in height & 1-2 feet in diameter. The acorns are eaten by a variety of wildlife. It grows along poorly drained river edges & floodplains, typically on clay soils.



Eastern White Pine reaches a mature size of 80-100 feet in height & 2-3 feet in diameter. It grows best on moist, sandy loam soils. This conifer provides thermal cover in winter for many species of animals and birds.



Red maple (*Acer rubrum*) reaches a mature size of up to 90 feet in height & 2½ feet in diameter. It grows on a variety of sites. Red maple is a popular shade & ornamental tree, with brilliant fall color.




Flowering Dogwood (*Cornus florida*)
 grows to 15-30 ft. height. Prefers moist, well-drained soils and full or part sun. Useful for wildlife habitat, slope stabilization, and as an ornamental.



50 Gallon Rain Barrels
 Collect and store rain water runoff from your rooftop via rain gutters. Great way to water your landscape and save money. The rain barrels are made of recycled plastic bottles. Kit includes all hardware for complete installation and directions.

Also available year-round at Culpeper SWCD office.



American Elderberry (*Sambucus canadensis*)
 Grows to 5-12 ft. height. Prefers moist, well-drained soils in full sun. White blooms with edible fruit. Attracts birds and butterflies.
