



Tree Seedling & Rain Barrel Sale

Any trees not picked up by 12pm March 14 are forfeited without a refund.

Trees benefit us and our environment by controlling erosion, reducing toxins, converting carbon dioxide to oxygen, and enhancing wildlife habitat.

Proceeds are used for CSWCD conservation education programs.



Eastern Redbud (*Cercis canadensis*) grows to 20-30 ft. height. It has beautiful showy "red buds" in spring. It grows in moist, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade.



Pin Oak (*Quercus palustris*) reaches a mature size of 70-90 feet and 2-3 feet in diameter. It is used by many game species. It tolerates many sites but thrives in the bottomland.



Virginia Pine (*Pinus virginiana*) reaches a mature size of 18-50 feet. It prefers well drained soils but can tolerate poor soils. It is useful for reforestation and wildlife.



Crab apple (*Malus sylvestris*) can reach a mature size of up to 35 feet in height. It grows on a variety of sites and is an excellent wildlife species. Full shade is preferred but they tolerate light shade.



Honey locust (*Gleditsia triacanthos*) is a hardy tree with many wildlife benefits. It can tolerate being in parking lot islands and still allow grass to grow. It can reach 100 feet tall but averages 35 feet.



50 Gallon Rain Barrels

Collect and store rain water runoff from your rooftop via rain gutters. Great way to water your landscape and save money. The rain barrels are made of recycled plastic bottles. Kit includes all hardware for complete installation and directions.

Also available year-round at Culpeper SWCD office.



Common buttonbush (*Cephalanthus occidentalis*) is an obligate wetland shrub suitable for wetland restoration, created wetlands & riparian zones. It has exceptional wildlife benefits. The seed is eaten by 8 species of waterfowl & the twigs by 3 species of mammals.
