He also reported that he attended the VASWCD's Annual Meeting where he was reelected as President, and the Virginia Soil and Water Board Meeting which he stated went well. He then awarded two Directors with service pins awarded by the VASWCD; Tom O'Halloran for fifteen years, and Robert Braford for twenty-five years.

7) STAFF REPORTS

- R. Jacobs reported that VCAP interest is increasing with three current payment approvals, and that he is planning to host workshops early in the coming year to cover program basics with County staff and other participants to keep the interest high.
- S. DeNicola reported that the Envirothon Training at Graves hosted over 150 people, some of whom traveled great distance to attend. She reported that the day went well with no weather issues. S.

DeNicola also reported that the final year of the three-year NOAA grant is this Spring and that she hopes to hire individuals from Shenandoah University to help.

- D. Massie reported that he attended the VASWCD Annual Meeting Luncheon and that the Gilley's (Rappahannock River Basin Award winners) were unable to attend because of illness. He will deliver their awards to them after the holidays.
- S. Yager reported that he also attended the VASWCD Annual Meeting Luncheon and that the Sedwick's (York River Basin Award winners) attended, participated, and were very grateful for the experience.
- K. Dellinger reported that she attended the Farm Transition Workshop hosted by Sarah Sharpe representing the District as a Sponsor and that about twenty people attended.
- G. Wichelns reported that the audit on December 19th will include two auditors and that the District Office is prepared. He also reported that the VASWCD Legislative Agenda from the VASWCD Board was ratified by the full membership and included an increase from \$500,000 to \$1,000,000 for small dam repair funding for the second year of the biennium. He also recognized Lily Smith, the District's most recent hire, for her hard work and success in completing over thirty verifications.

8) AGENCY REPORTS

DCR – D. Cross took a moment to explain the importance of BMP verifications for the Bay Model and also applauded Lily Smith on her dedication to getting these done. She also congratulated Robert Bradford and Tom O'Halloran for receiving their service pins. D. Cross submitted a written report and highlighted a few items to pay attention to: Quarterly Reports will be due on January 17th, Grant Deliverables Annual Reviews will need to be completed and documented in Board Meeting Minutes, and Mid-Year Employee Evaluations should be completed during the month of January. She also urged all to take a look at the section of her report that discusses Tax Credit Items.

NRCS – R. Rexrode submitted a written report which was passed out as a handout.

<u>VDOF</u> – E. Furlow reported that the Department currently has four job openings that will be taking applications until Mid-January and is working towards a fully staffed office. He also reported that the Hardwood Cost-Share Tax Credit Program is still being processed but is expected to become active soon.
