1) CALL TO ORDER

L. Graves called the meeting to order at 10:28 AM.

2) EASEMENT LANGUAGE

G. Wichelns gave the Board a brief overview of a recently published IRS notice regarding original language in conservation easements containing boundary line adjustment provisions and/or extinguishment provisions. It was brought to the District's attention through a Newsletter from the Virginia Outdoors Foundation (VOF) that was sent to Robert Bradford, Director, that there has been an IRS recommended amendment to some of the original language of easements. (See Attachment) The new proposed language gives donors the opportunity to amend original easement language by replacing it with recommended IRS language to protect themselves from potential future IRS enforcement in regard to easement extinguishment and boundary line adjustments only. The IRS has provided "Safe Harbor" language that can be used to substitute for original language that could trigger an audit. All amendments must be filed by July 24, 2023. Mr. Bradford worked with his attorney to amend his easement which is held by VOF and co-held by the District. Mr. Bradford would like the District to support his proposed changes and sign off on them today. After discussion the Board decided it would be best not to send alerts to other easements that are co-held by the District.

R. Brame moved to approve amending the language on Mr. Bradford's Easement on property owned by Glendale Farms LLC and not to send alerts to other easement owners. T. O'Halloran seconded the motion. R. Bradford abstained. (R. Brame. T. O'Halloran, unanimous)
