8) STAFF REPORTS

D. Massie reported on upcoming Engineering Job Approval Authority (EJAA) reviews with Amanda Pennington, DCR District Engineering Services Manager. He also reported that none of the District submissions were selected to receive any Grand River Basin Awards this year from DCR.

R. Jacobs reported that S. DeNicola has completed MWEE programs at William Monroe High School in Greene County and classroom sessions at schools in Culpeper and Madison counties. He stated that he plans to participate in a Lake of the Woods Town Hall session tomorrow evening to present on Virginia Conservation Assistance Program (VCAP) opportunities as well as water quality and flooding. He provided an update on VCAP budget meetings, noting that approvals are progressing slowly and that the waitlist remains long. He further reported that the Rappahannock/Rapidan Regional Commission and the Friends of the Rappahannock are collaborating with Orange County public lands on potential stormwater BMP projects. Finally, he recognized Greg’s upcoming retirement and expressed appreciation for the opportunity to work for him.

T. Talley reported that he has completed Conservation Planning Training and is now developing a conservation plan. Once the plan is finalized, he will be eligible for certification.

G. Wichelns reported on his efforts to train and prepare David Massie and Stevie Ross in anticipation of his upcoming retirement. He provided an overview of the “Local Funding” source, clarifying that despite its name, it does not include county funds but rather consists of unused state grant funds. He concluded with remarks of gratitude, encouraging the group to continue working together as a strong and effective team.

She reminded Directors of their FOIA and COIA training requirements and provided a reminder to District staff regarding completion of IT Security Training. She informed the group that CAS-related issues and assistance requests should now be directed to the new CAS Help Desk email. She reviewed tax credit

and CCI enrollment reminders and advised the Board of a recent update to Virginia Soil and Water Conservation Board (VSWCB) policy language pertaining to cost-share approval dates. She concluded by reviewing additional upcoming dates and deadlines and expressing sincere appreciation to Greg for his many years of dedicated service and leadership.

B. Jarvis, a former Director of the Culpeper Soil and Water Conservation District, attended the meeting to express his appreciation to Greg in recognition of his upcoming retirement. He noted that he was present at Greg's first Board meeting and wished to be present for his last as well. Mr. Jarvis stated that he believes Greg has greatly enhanced the scope and impact of the District, providing a consistently educational and conservation-focused experience throughout his tenure. He concluded by offering his sincere thanks and congratulations.
